Summary Report

Synopsis:

Bottisham Medical Practice utilised the General Practice Assessment Questionnaire (GPAQ) to survey the views of patients attending their surgery during winter 2012 / 2013.

This report summarises the 212 GPAQ responses that were received by 17th January 2013.

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1. Introduction:

- 1.1 Bottisham Medical Practice utilised the General Practice Assessment Questionnaire (GPAQ) to survey the views of patients attending their surgery during winter 2012 / 2013.
- 1.2 212 GPAQ forms were completed by patients and returned to Bottisham Medical Practice by 17th January 2013.
- 1.3 15 Bottisham GPAQ forms were incomplete (i.e. three or more of the GPAQ groups of questions had not been answered). These incomplete forms have not been included within this Questionnaire analysis.
- 1.4 This report summarises the responses within the aforementioned 197 (i.e. 212 15) completed Bottisham GPAQ forms that were returned to the Medical Practice by 17th January 2013.
- 1.5 Many Bottisham respondents did not answer all of the GPAQ questions, so the percentages within the Question summaries below refer to the total number of respondents who answered each specific question.
- 1.6 The GPAQ response percentages have been rounded to the nearest whole number for ease of comparison. In some instances, this has resulted in the percentage 'totals' equalling 99% or 101%.
- 1.7 Detailed information regarding all the data included within this summary report may be obtained from the Bottisham Practice Manager.
